CalMAN Complete Uninstall

CalMAN Clean Uninstall

Use the following procedure to totally clean a CalMAN installation from a computer:

1. Uninstall CalMAN in Control Panel / Programs and Features.
2. Delete CalMAN directories.
 - a. Delete the
 \Documents\SpectraCal\CalMAN directory.
 - b. Delete the
 C:\Program Files (x86)\SpectraCal\CalMAN directory, if it exists.
 - c. Delete the
 C:\ProgramData\SpectraCal\CalMAN directory, if it exists.

To view the *Program Data* directory, you may need to make hidden folders visible on your computer:

- i. Go to Control Panel / Folder Options / View tab
 - ii. Under “Hidden files and folders,” select “Show hidden files, folders, and drives.”
3. Delete CalMAN Registry folders.
 - a. In the Windows Search or Run box (Windows Start), type “regedit.”
 - b. In the Registry Editor, delete the
 HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Portrait Displays, Inc\CalMAN
 folder, if it exists.
 - c. In the Registry Editor, delete the
 HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Portrait Displays, Inc\CalMAN
 folder, if it exists.

Done. CalMAN is completely uninstalled.
