

# VideoEq Pro Quick Start Guide



## In the box

In addition to the VideoEq Pro unit, you will find a universal power supply, a 2 meter HDMI cable and a 2 meter USB-A to USB-mini cable.

## Connecting the VideoEq Pro to your video display

Remove the HDMI connector from your video display and connect it to the port on the back of the VideoEq Pro labeled *HDMI In*. Use an HDMI cable to the VideoEq Pro port labeled *HDMI Out* and your video display. The red Link OK button on the front panel will show that the VideoEq Pro is correctly connected to the display.

## Using the Front Panel buttons

Use the button labeled Preset Modes to switch between the tables that ship with the VideoEq Pro. After you load Custom tables (described below), you can use the *custom mode* button to switch between custom tables.

## Connecting the VideoEq Pro to a PC

Connect a USB connector to your PC and to the (Mini B) USB port on the VideoEq Pro.

## Using with the CalMAN V4 interactive Workflow

In the CalMAN V4 interactive workflow select the AV foundry VideoEq Pro and click connect.
